

DEAR PARENTS

Arrowhead Native Bible Center is a ministry of the Northern Canada **Evangelical Mission. Each camp offers** many wholesome sports and recreational activities as well as maintaining a standard of Bible instruction. At the camp you will experience a wonderful Christian atmosphere for your young people to enjoy. Your children will be under capable supervision during the day and night. Every precaution is taken for the health and safety of each individual. A gualified medic will be present during the week your child is at camp. For the protection of all children at camp. a brief lice check will be performed during the registration process for each camper. Campers with evidence of lice will not be permitted to register for camp, this is a health and safety issue.

Camp registration is first come, first served and space is limited. To ensure availability, we strongly recommend that your children's registration form and fees be sent in as soon as possible. We have only 40 spots available per week, so register early to ensure you have a spot. If you are planning to send a group of children from your community, please contact Arrowhead at the number on this form to make arrangements to register the correct number of spaces. To register we ask that a parent or guardian sign the registration form; we ask also that the camper sign the form, understanding that they are indicating that they will obey all of the camp rules while they are with us.

FROM MONCTON

Traveling West on the new four lane highway - Take exit #365 and follow the #10 West for 8.3 km, take a right turn at the Chipman / Minto exit (you will still be on the #10 west.) Follow this road for 16.2 km to Cox Point Road. Turn left on to the Cox Point Loop Road. You will drive for a few hundred yards to a "T" in the road, turn left and continue down the Cox Point Road to Arrowhead at Civic #622. Turn right on to our driveway and come on down.

FROM FREDERICTON

Traveling East on the new four lane highway - Take exit #347 towards Mill Cove and Chipman. Travel route #105 for 13.8 km, turn left onto route #10 West at the Chipman / Minto exit. Follow this road for 16.2 km to Cox Point Road. Turn left on to the Cox Point Loop Road. You will drive for a few hundred yards to a "T" in the road, turn left and continue down the Cox Point Road to Arrowhead at Civic #622. Turn right on to our driveway and come on down.
