The Minute-Man raised \$87,202.87 and will be divided among various NCEM camp projects. We aim to keep you as Minute-Men updated as these funds are used.

One of our missionaries came into my office excited about being able to go on an outreach trip. Covid had many communities throughout the North shut down, and there was a window of opportunity opening.

"I want to take a small team over the winter roads. I want to distribute literature and videos through many of the northern villages. Do we have enough money?" he asked. I smiled and told him, "There is always enough money to do evangelism! We will find the money somewhere, but God will supply if we are busy about reaching the lost!" I told him to "get busy and start assembling the team and get ready to go. God will supply the money!"

Canada is one of the most expensive fields in which to do ministry because of its vast distances and extreme temperatures. NCEM has always been very careful in the stewardship of the finances that have come in, so we would always have enough money to do outreach.

This Minute-Man Call (#170) will be used to top up our **Evangelism & Outreach Fund.** Specifically, we use this fund to **pay for materials and all expenses associated with outreach.** We will also use a portion of this Minute-Man call to help **bring missionaries off the field to our staff conferences.** We value our "Family Devotions" time and want all our missionaries to be able to participate.

Thank you to all our faithful Minute-Men! With your help, NCEM is able to continue the work of the ministry!

There are many other facility and equipment upgrades that Minute-Man helped accomplish at Big River Bible Camp, Higher Challenge Wilderness Adventures and Camp Kwayakotage. Praise the Lord for His wonderful provision.

We want to offer them a glass of refreshing cold water and some scrumptious food for their bellies, but this would all be for naught if we were not able to present the Gospel message.
