Lots of work has already been put into the women's dorm – like flooring, paint, doors and repairs. However, the road to fixing and updating can seem like a long process!

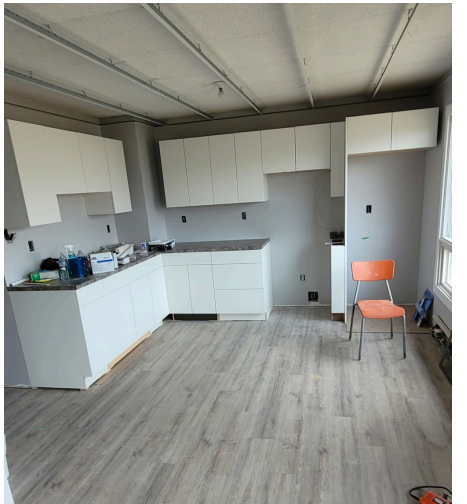
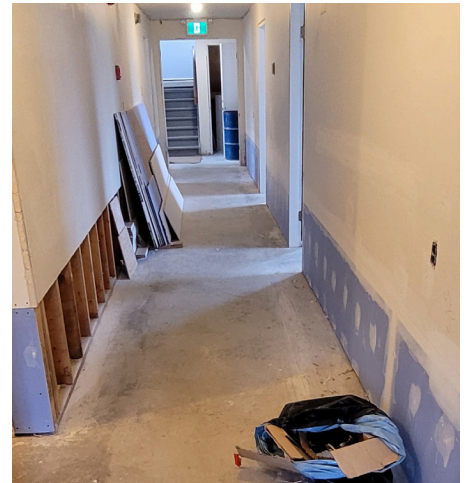
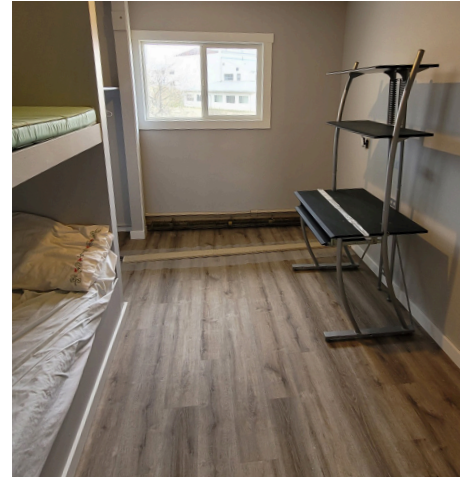
With your Minute-Man contributions, we are excited to continue with our
